How do we organise under lockdown?

Determined organising is critical for working class communities to survive the current storm of coronavirus.

Social Solidarity is the key organising principle – unity within working class communities to facilitate communal responses to the virus.

Because the virus spreads easily from person to person, **conditions for such determined organising are difficult.**

Small groups will be key drivers of efforts to accelerate communal responses at local neighbourhood level.

These groups can also **facilitate contacts with community structures** such youth groups, church groups, local sports clubs – to advance social solidarity!

Depending on the progress in the initial work of making contacts with local organisations, the small groups can explore possibilities of **forming community neighbourhood structures** to continue organising, without endangering the community.

The small groups or community neighbourhood structures will **establish contacts with other communities** to share experiences and information on fighting the virus.
