1. Refugee Permit
2. Unabridged birth certificate
3. Permanent residence
4. Study permit
4. Asylum Seeker permit

If you do not have documents, the Courts have ruled that schools **must register your child** while you wait for your documents.

All documents must be certified. This service of online school registration will be provided for free.
